As I draw closer to completing my edits for the UW Medical School Clerkship Catalog, I would like to update you on changes that have been made.

In its original state, the catalog was exported from an internal database – it was never designed with the user's needs in mind. As a result, information was difficult to disseminate for several reasons: the content did not rely on navigational aids, was often redundant, and was presented in a claustrophobic manner.

In order to improve for navigation, I decided to start from scratch. I wanted all important information to be found easily. After carefully reviewing the catalog, I decided to pursue a new structural design, which includes clear labels ("credits", "duration", "pre-reqs", "permissions", "availability", and "notes") for navigational aids. Additionally, I utilized color contrast in order to organize information in a clear hierarchy.

To minimize redundancy, I carefully reviewed the catalog and removed any duplicate information. For example, locations were originally mentioned in this format: "St. Vincent's Healthcare Billings - Billings, MT; Billings, MT" – this is not easily readable. In my revision, all information is much more concise, and the format always consistent: ("Specific location; City, State" = "St. Vincent Health Care; Billings, MT"). Although these changes may appear superficial, the original catalog had hundreds of instances of redundancy, and these ultimately add up to interfere with usability.

To address the claustrophobic presentation of information, I provided clear separation between information by adding blank space. I also introduced multiple columns (original was arranged in a single-column), which provided a more dynamic structure. This distinguished the new document from the original; at first glance, the pre-edited catalog looked like a single disorganized block of text.

As I come close finishing my edits, I would like to say thank you the opportunity to develop and refine my technical editing. Please let me know if you have any questions, feedback, or requests for further modification of the catalog.
